

**IMPORTANT INFORMATION REGARDING SELECTION FOR THE
ADVANCED CARE PARAMEDIC PROGRAM – FALL 2012**

Thank you for applying to the Advanced Care Paramedic (PARM) program at Georgian College for the Fall 2012 intake. As an applicant to the PARM program, you must have already completed a Primary Care Paramedic program or have obtained equivalency status through the Ontario Ministry of Health and Long Term Care. In addition, candidates must have current primary care paramedic experience in an ambulance service with a minimum of 2,000 hours. If you are not certified as a primary care paramedic, please apply to the Primary Care Paramedic program, code PARA. PARM applicants must complete an assessment exam as part of the selection process as well as submit a current resume. The exam will assess your knowledge related to practice as a Primary Care Paramedic as well as knowledge related to anatomy and physiology, pathophysiology, patient care theory and pharmacology.

Your resume should contain information about your academic background and work experience, etc.

Test results will be released online to applicants as of March 15, 2012 (refer to Web for Admission Instructions which can be found at our web site: http://www.georgianc.on.ca/admissions/downloads/ocas_wfa_instructions.pdf)

BOOKING YOUR TEST
