Motorcycle Training – Basic (M1 Exit) DRVR 0003

Fee: \$429

"Gearing Up": Learn to ride safely in this 19-hour Canada Safety Council National Motorcycle Training Program offered by Georgian College in Barrie, Midland, Muskoka, Orangeville, Orillia, Owen Sound and new this year, South Georgian Bay.

This program is suitable for both novice and experienced riders.

The first night of the course is in the classroom with the remainder taking place in a parking lot riding motorcycles provided by Georgian College in a supervised environment.

We ride rain or shine!

Ratios:

- one student per motorcycle
- five students per instructor

Basic skills you will learn:

Balancing, braking, cold starting, stopping, moving off and stopping, correct gear changing, signalling and shoulder checking, slow-riding and pattern riding.

Advanced skills you will learn:

Traffic behaviour, collision avoidance, introduction to decision-making, emergency braking and dealing with obstacles.

The M1 Exit test is administered at the end of the course by certified instructors. **You must obtain the Level One licence at the MTO if you want to be tested at the end of the course.** After successful examination of driving skills, forms are signed by the examiner who is an approved signing authority, and returned to the MTO for processing as well as CSC graduate certificate.

Successful completion of the motorcycle training program reduces the Level Two licensing period from 22 months to 18 months. It *may* also qualify you for potential insurance discounts.

M2 Exit DRV R 0004

Fee: \$341

Upgrade to the full M license. This 12-hour program is designed to prepare students for their final motorcycle riding skills or M2 Exit test. The program consists of three segments: a classroom portion, a range or parking lot portion, and a road or street portion. Student must have held M2 license for a minimum of 22 months (or 18 months if successfully completed at recognized motorcycle training program). **Students supply and ride their own motorcycles for the M2 Exit training and test.** Upon completion of the program, students book their road tests with the College. Road tests are administered by certified instructors.

Program length – eight hours
• two hours of classroom • six hours of on-bike

Program prerequisites

Students must hold an M or M2 license with riding experience; demonstrate entry-level riding ability; if using a personally owned motorcycle for the program; it must be currently licensed and insured, street legal and pass a pre-ride safety inspection.

Freshen up your skills!

Students who successfully complete this program receive a Canada Safety Council Refresher Course certificate which **may** have a beneficial affect on their insurance premiums.
