

Chartwells Meal Plan & Convenience Cards General Information

The **Georgian College Meal Plan** is a non-mandatory, tax-exempt plan, and is offered to all students applying to Georgian College.

The Plan is non-refundable.

The Meal Plan is valid for the purchase of food and non-alcoholic beverages served in the main cafeteria and at the Tim Horton's managed by Chartwells at anytime they are open.

Non-taxable Meal Plans require that a minimum of \$900.00 per 15 week semester be consumed. With a non-taxable plan, students are not charged any taxes on the food and non-alcoholic beverages they purchase. Non-food, confectionary and vending machine items cannot be purchased with a Tax Exempt meal plan. Any balance at the end of each semester is non-refundable.

The student can add to the Georgian College Meal Plan in \$50.00 increments at anytime and maintain the non-taxable status by contacting Chartwells to make these payments.

Only the designated student can present his/her meal plan card. The student cannot lend his/her meal plan card to others nor make purchases on the card for others.

It is very important that you report a lost or stolen card immediately to the Food Services Manager. Your missing card will be deactivated immediately and a new card issued to you at the cost of \$ 15.00. Neither the College nor any foodservice outlet is responsible for any losses during the period of loss of the card until the account is deactivated.

Chartwells Convenience Cards (Taxable Meal Plans) require a minimum purchase of \$25.00

Convenience Cards are valid for the purchase of food and non-alcoholic beverages served in the main cafeteria and at the Tim Horton's managed by Chartwells at anytime they are open.

Convenience Plans are available to students, faculty, staff and the general public, can added to in \$20.00 increments at anytime, and never expire.

It is very important that you report a lost or stolen card immediately to the Food Services Manager. Your missing card will be deactivated immediately and a new card issued to you at the cost of \$ 15.00. Neither the College nor any foodservice outlet is responsible for any losses during the period of loss of the card until the account is deactivated.
