Admission Requirements

OSS applicants require Grade 12 English (C) or (U) (ENG4C, ENG4U). Recommended subjects include: Any Grade 12 College Mathematics (MAP 4C or MCT 4C), or any Grade 12 University Mathematics.

Students are required to sign a waiver indicating they are physically and medically able to participate in strenuous physical activity.

Applicants must have a valid Standard First Aid and CPR Level C or HCP certificate before proceeding to field placement or participating in volunteer opportunities. It is recommended that First Aid and CPR training is completed prior to program entry.

Criminal Reference Check

Field placement agencies require an up-to-date clear criminal reference check and vulnerable sector check prior to the start of the program. Students should obtain their criminal reference check no sooner than one month prior to the beginning of the school year; checks conducted earlier may not be considered current. Students are required to provide these checks prior to program start. NOTE: A record of criminal offences, for which a pardon has not been granted, may prevent the student from completing graduation requirements.

Graduation Requirements

- 2 Communications Courses
- 3 General Education Courses
- 1 Field Placement

Graduation Eligibility

To graduate from this program, the passing weighted average for promotion through each semester, from year to year and to graduate is 60%. Additionally, a student must attain a minimum of 50% or a letter grade of P (Pass) or S (Satisfactory) in each course in each semester.
