### Admission Requirements

OSS applicants must have Grade 12 English (C) or (U) (ENG4C, ENG4U).

Applicants must have up-to-date immunization records in compliance with the Day Nurseries Act and a valid Standard First Aid certificate before proceeding on field placement. It is recommended that First Aid training be completed prior to program entry.

Strong written and interpersonal skills are recommended.

#### Volunteer Hours

Students are required to complete 30 hours of volunteering in a licensed child care service/school setting, within the first semester or they will not be permitted to proceed to field placement. It is recommended that applicants begin volunteering before classes begin, so as to reduce time constraints during the academic semester. Related work and/or co-op experience is recognized in completion of this requirement.

#### Criminal Reference Check

All field placement settings require an up-to-date criminal reference check as a condition of acceptance for placement. If required, students should obtain their criminal reference check no sooner than one month before the placement begins. Checks conducted earlier may not be considered current.

Applicants who are 19 years of age or over by the first day of classes, and who lack the academic admission qualifications, may be considered for entrance as mature students. Each applicant will be considered on an individual basis and acceptance will be determined by counseling, Communication Placement Assessment (CPA), previous post-secondary education and evaluation of experience. Some programs also have specific prerequisite requirements that must be met prior to admission. Mature applicants must meet all program specific prerequisites. Those applying as mature students and having no documentation of Grade 12 education must supply, if requested, proof of age, such as a copy of an official birth certificate or driver's license.

**NOTE:** A record of criminal offences may prevent the student from completing graduation requirements.

### Graduation Eligibility

To graduate from this program, the passing weighted average for promotion through each semester, from year to year and to graduate is 60%. Additionally, a student must attain a minimum of 50% or a letter grade of P (Pass) or S (Satisfactory) in each course in each semester.
